Promoter's Conditions

• The promoter of the meet shall be Cirencester Swimming Club

Purpose:

- To run internal club championships as a licensed closed meet for the development of inexperienced athletes and those seeking to compete outside their own club environment. Times recorded are not acceptable for entry to Regional and National events.
- The meet is licensed at level 4 and shall be run under ASA laws and the Technical Rules of Swimming and these promoter's conditions.

Entrants:

- All entrants must be ASA registered and have been a member of Cirencester Swimming Club for at least 3 months prior to the competition (swimmers who join within this 3 month period may apply to swim for a time only result and will not be eligible for Cirencester Swimming Club medals or records).
- Dual club members who have swum for Cirencester Swimming Club at Counties in that year shall be eligible to compete for medals and trophies, other dual club swimmers may apply to swim for a time only result.
- Should the event become oversubscribed the promoter reserves the right to accept entrants on a first come, first serve basis.
- Age groups are Under 9, 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16 and 17 & Over. Age will be as at 31st
 December 2016.
- Heats will be seeded according to entry times and the final heat for each event shall be spearheaded.
- Entries will only be accepted by the submission of a properly completed entry form, returned prior to the closing date and including the entry fee payable to Cirencester Swimming Club.
- Entry is open to all members who swim in the competitive squads (Phoenix, Dolphins and Sealions and excludes Otters) of Cirencester Swimming Club.
- Sprint events are restricted to 25m for under 9s, 50m for 9/10 & 11/12 and 100m for all swimmers aged 13 and over. Only swimmers aged 9 and over may compete in the 200m IM.
- There are no qualifying times for this meet, please submit short course times.

• The competition shall be held in a 6 lane, 25m pool with anti-wave lane ropes and turning flags at both ends. Manual timing will be in operation. All starts will be over the top unless stated by the Referee.

Administration

- The promoter reserves the right to amend the Schedule of Events based on the number of entries for events and the time available per session. The promoter's decision will be final.
- Medals will be awarded.
- All competitors and swimmers shall observe the rules of Cirencester Swimming Club and Cirencester Leisure Centre and comply with any instructions given by the staff. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any spectator, coach or swimmer.
- Swimmers must not leave the pool or changing area without first notifying a chaperone and drying off and putting on appropriate clothing and footwear.
- Results will be posted on the club website and noticeboard after the event and passed to the ASA for inclusion in the ASA rankings database.
- All swimmers must sign in prior to the commencement of the warm up for each session.
- Where events occur that are not covered by the above Conditions they will either be
 referred to the Meet Referee for a decision on technical issues or to the Promoter. The
 outcome of any decision will be based on ASA Law or Technical Rules or in the spirit of
 fairness and equity and will be announced accordingly.
- The Promoter reserves the right to alter or amend any of the above conditions as required, any such changes will be announced at the meet.
- The Promoter reserves the right to remove, from the competition, a swimmer who displays unacceptable behaviour or language.
- The Promoters do not accept any responsibility for incorrect entries and will not make any changes to times or events entered for swimmers.
- In accordance with ASA Child Protection policy, all photographic equipment including mobile phones with cameras must be registered at each session.
- Meet entries shall be managed on a computer. Your consent to the holding of personal
 information for the purposes of the meet shall be treated as given by the submission of your
 entries, as shall your consent for such details to be published both during and after the
 meet.
- Non competitors are NOT ALLOWED on poolside unless approved as a coach, official or designated helper.
